



Creating conditions for successful cooperative partnership working

GASPH PARTNERSHIP TERMS OF ENGAGEMENT

As a Partner of the Global Antimicrobial Stewardship Partnership Hub (GASPH) organisations confirm that they are:

- 1 Dedicated to meeting the education and training needs of the global infection healthcare community and sharing good practice through multi-stakeholder engagement across all health economies. Initially all hub resources will be in English but with a view to developing content in other languages where an English translation is also available.
- 2 Strategically aligned to GASPH Partner organisations in the areas of:
 - A Promotion of educational and good clinical practice resources, including guidelines, case studies and quality improvement interventions, on effective antimicrobial usage to healthcare professionals globally.
 - B Education and training through events and e-learning, including podcasts and webinars/videos, both open access and fee based.
 - C Supporting robust scientific quality of resources for engagement and public communication about antimicrobial resistance (AMR) and antimicrobial stewardship (AMS).
 - D Providing support, where possible and appropriate, to undergraduate healthcare students (medical, nursing, pharmacy, and biomedical science) to strengthen their capacities to address AMR and AMS in their practice, through professional networks, mentoring and provision of training and education resources.
- 3 Committed to the following actions:
 - A Registration of organisation within the Hub, including a core set of information, a named contact who will actively participate, and permissions to be contacted.
 - B Agreement to participate as a representative on the **Global Advisory Board**. Representatives will act in the interests of the Hub, offering expertise both in relation to their economic territory and on behalf of their Partner Organisation.
 - C Agreement to submit via a standard template relevant peer and non-peer reviewed education and good practice resources for open access sharing, or resources for peer review and publication for open access.
 - D Hosting of a link to the Hub and promotion of the same via their website, social media, and other communication channels.

- E Participation in Global Advisory Board meetings and at least one online collaborative meeting each year which are aimed at developing partnership working.
- 4 Final provisions: the small print:
- A The Terms of Engagement reflects the views and intentions of the BSAC to co-operate on a non-exclusive basis, expressed in good faith but without the creation of any legal or financial obligations or the incurrance of any liability on the part of any of them.
 - B It is understood and agreed that nothing in these Terms of Engagement will constitute, or be construed as, an offer, promise or undertaking to finance all or part of any activity or project identified in or pursuant to the aims of GASPH. All resources hosted on the GASPH website will remain the intellectual property of the organisation that developed it.
 - C If opportunities are identified, specific arrangements for any such activity or project, including securement of funding or other financial arrangements would need to be agreed upon between the Partner Organisation undertaking collaborative projects or working.
 - D Nothing in the Terms of Engagement will limit the right of, or prevent, any Partner from entering memoranda or arrangements with other parties with respect to any activity, project or area of co-operation covered by the scope of GASPH.
 - E Any dispute arising out of, or in connection with, the interpretation or application of any provision of the Terms of Engagement will be settled amicably through consultations.
